General and Intensive English courses

Our General and Intensive English courses are designed to meet your language needs. The General English Course has 15 hours of teaching timetabled per week, and the Intensive English Course has 21 hours. Before you book, tell us what you want to achieve and we'll find the English course that is for you.

Our General and Intensive English courses include lessons that build on the four language skills – writing, reading, speaking and listening – as well as focus on grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.

Summer Course Supplement

Our summer course supplement is applied to our General and Intensive English courses of 9 weeks or less from 28th June to 23rd August 2026.

Summer Activity Package

Our summer activity package is available during our summer season, from 14th June to 23rd August 2025. It includes our fun and varied activity programme, with local trips, sports activities, Saturday full day excursions, and selected evening activities.

Cambridge English Examination Courses

Our B2 First and C1 Advanced courses will only run with a minimum of 3 students. The average class size is 4 students, with a maximum of 10 students.

Homestay / residential accommodation and extras

15-year-old students staying for more than 27 nights must stay in Private Foster Family Homestay Accommodation, due to UK laws

All homestay accommodation includes:

- Homestay within walking distance or a short bus journey from the school
- Light laundry once a week
- Breakfast and dinner from Monday to Friday and full board from host at weekends
- Full board also includes the above, as well as packed lunch from the school
- Single room is guaranteed for 18-year-olds during low season and summer season, 16 and 17-year-olds during the low season

Residential accommodation includes:

- Residential accommodation in university campus, single room, with en-suite and shared kitchen
- No food included (self-catered)
- No laundry included
- Only available for students aged 18+

Allergies/dietary requirements:

You must tell us about any food needs or allergies in this form and before the student comes. This is to keep the student safe. If you give us wrong or missing information, you will need to pay £100.

Airport Transfers (Private)

- Pick up point will be confirmed with you when we have the flight details.
- On arrival, a £40/hour waiting charge is applied if the driver has to wait longer than 2 hours after the flight landing time.
- UK Border Agency may refuse to allow students under 18 into the UK unless they have written parental consent to travel or have proof of their onward travel arrangements

Summer Collective Transfers

- May involve a wait of approx 2/3 hours
- Students that require assistance with check in on departure will be charged an additional £80 which includes a 1 hour wait with the taxi driver. Additional hours: £40 per hour

Junior General English courses

You can book onto our Junior Summer English Courses for a minimum of one week but many students choose to stay for longer. Students have 15 one-hour lessons each week, from Monday to Friday. Classes are small, averaging 12 students per class (maximum 16).

Summer Activities

Summer Collective Transfers

Summer collective transfers are not available for any students using the Unaccompanied Minor Service with airline on arrival or departure. Students that require assistance with check in on departure will be charged an additional £80 which includes 1 hour wait with taxi driver. Additional hours charged at £35 per hour. Flight details must be sent and paid two weeks before arrival

Special educational needs / mental health issues

At the time of booking, we MUST be told about ANY special educational needs and/or mental health issues. These include but are not limited to: ADHD, Dyslexia, and Asperger's Syndrome

As much information as possible should be given so we can assess if we are able to accept the student.

If a student arrives with special educational needs that we have not been told about and we are not able to teach/integrate them successfully, we will have to cancel their course. Students will be sent home at their own expense, but remaining course fees will be refunded. Check Terms & Conditions

Accommodation

Private foster family homestay: Due to UK laws protecting children under the age of 16, students aged 10 – 15 staying longer than 27 nights will need to be placed with a family that is registered as a private foster family with social services.

Homestay accommodation information:

- Only available for students aged 10+
- Full board accommodation (twin room, breakfast and dinner from hosts and freshly prepared packed lunch from school Monday to Friday. Saturday and Sunday from host family.
- Light laundry once a week
- All within walking distance or a short bus journey from the school
- 15-year-olds must follow a 10pm (22:00) curfew, 13 and 14 year-olds must follow a 9pm (21:00) curfew, and 12-year-olds are not allowed out unsupervised. No exceptions.
- All families hosting under 18-year-olds are police checked (DBS)
- All families who host our junior students are chosen for their friendly and caring attitude
- All junior students may share a room with another student of a similar age and same gender and possibly same nationality during busy periods

Extras and supplements

Under 12 surcharge: This charge is to cover additional staffing costs required by UK law for individual students

Airport Transfers (Private)

- Unaccompanied Minor Service is required for junior students who are too young to fly unaccompanied - this is determined by the airline and the age of the students varies, so please check with the airline you have booked with. There will be an additional charge of £120 which includes check in at the airline counter and a wait of up to 2 hours by the driver. Additional hours are charged at £40/hour.
- Pick up point will be confirmed with you when we have the flight details.
- On arrival, a £40/hour waiting charge is applied if the driver has to wait longer than 2 hours after the flight landing time.
- UK Border Agency may refuse to allow students under 18 into the UK unless they have written parental consent to travel or have proof of their onward travel arrangements
